What is RESTORATIVE JUSTICE?

Restorative justice is an approach to justice that emphasizes living in right relationship and resonates deeply with Gospel values and Catholic social teaching.

In restorative justice, crime and harm are understood in terms of the people and relationships impacted, rather than solely the law or rule that was broken. Restorative practices seek to repair harm through transformative encounters that model Jesus' reconciling way.

"Justice is properly sought solely out of love of justice itself, out of respect for the victims, as a means of preventing new crimes and protecting the common good, not as an alleged outlet for personal anger."

Becoming a Restorative Institution


Develop restorative justice as an organization's primary response to internal harms and injustices.

Partner with external organizations dedicated to restorative justice and provide supports that might help it thrive and grow.




